

JOTC PHASE LOAD OUT

MANDATORY EQUIPMENT:

Uniform (2 sets) – Preferably OCP or Jungle Uniform (OD Green or Tiger Stripe). You can wear whatever you have available that is appropriate in a MILITARY environment – You WILL be getting hot, dirty and wet.

Boots – Must be broken in – wear boots approved for wear with your chosen uniform

PT uniform. Shorts, T-shirt, socks and tennis shoes (sneakers, gym shoes, whatever you wish to call them).

A pair of gloves for rope class. Tactical gloves, or Mechanix gloves from Wal-Mart auto department work very well (about 10 bucks).

Snack Food. Whatever you like. We always feed you well at JOTC.

Rain Gear, poncho, rain suit etc.

Basic First Aid Kit... you decide.

WATER!!! LOTS.

Dude wipes to remove face camo.

After hours clothes to lounge in.

Load Bearing Gear

Ear Protection – You will be shooting live ammunition. Earmuffs or earplugs.

Hydration Gear – Camelbak or canteen.

Small brown or green towel – this will be used to keep your neck cool in the field.

Socks – 4-6 pairs

At least 6 pair underwear and undershirts appropriate for wear with chosen uniform

Large band aids or moleskin to be used on feet

Medications that you take. Be sure to inform the medic of your meds schedule so he can check on you.

Foot powder

Field Hygiene products/toiletries

Pillow and sheets/blanket for your bunk - Whatever you need to sleep comfortable.

Flashlight/headlamp – MUST have red LED/Lens

Airsoft/paintball weapon, facemask, ammo/CO₂ –you will be engaging enemy all week so bring enough to sustain you in battle. If you don't have this you can rent it on site.

Bring gear to keep you warm if it gets chilly, and it has happened at night. At least have a fleece jacket.

Bug repellent. Very important!

Face cammo stick or compact

Field Knife and or Machete if you have one

Fire starting equipment

550 Para-cord (50 feet minimum suggested)

Compass – Lensatic style recommended

Large zip lock bag for AO maps

Notepad (1) and Pens (2)

If you wish to qualify using your own M16/AR15, you may bring your weapon. We will need to know if you plan to bring your own weapon. NOTE: Your weapon will be inspected by range safety officer and secured at check in. For the safety of the school, you will NOT be permitted to access this weapon until you are called to qualify by the range safety officer, and it will NOT be returned to your custody until the conclusion of the course.

80 rounds .223 or .556 ammo for your weapons qualification. Ammunition will NOT be provided by the school. It is YOUR responsibility to bring this with you.

NOTE: You will have access to bathroom and shower facilities in your barracks. But in the field, be prepared to handle your business ... (Toilet Paper).
